

# The 18th Century *Relaciones Geográficas*: A Bibliography

THE *Relaciones Geográficas* of 18th century Mexico, or New Spain, were doubtless inspired by the encyclopedic series made in all the colonies of Spain two centuries before, at the order of Philip II. Many of the Mexican part of the 1580 series have been published by Paso y Troncoso,<sup>1</sup> whose stature as a scholar increases with the circulation of each long-delayed work, and these must always form a cornerstone for any serious study of the ethnography, history, or economy of the country.

The 18th century group, which seem to have been made in New Spain only, are less known. They offer information on the location, communications, and physical environments of towns from the Isthmus to Chihuahua, on their fauna and flora, antiquities, regional costume, mineralogy, metalurgy, and — the still-debatable and fashionable topic of 18th century learning — fossils and petrifications. These matters are unevenly discussed — the *Relación* of San Buenaventura is practically all Hallelujahs — but at times are rich in detail.

The list which follows attempts to include all the known *Relaciones*, first under the name of the town and state as they appear in the Atlas of the Secretaría de Agricultura y Fomento, 1919-21, then as the name was written by its local author. Abbreviations are explained at the end of this note.

The majority of the originals are preserved in the Biblioteca Nacional de Madrid, Ms. 2449 and 2450. The titles are listed by Julian Paz<sup>2</sup> and by Silvio Zavala<sup>3</sup> with minor discrepancies. These volumes have been copied twice: once in longhand by Paso y Troncoso, and again by Dr. Sanford Mosk photographically. The first

set of copies is preserved in the Museo Nacional de México, the second is in the Department of Geography, University of California at Berkeley. In addition to the Madrid Mss. there is a volume of various copies made in the 19th century from these and other originals whose location is not stated. It contains the valuable Nayarit series, and is preserved in the Biblioteca Nacional de México,<sup>4</sup> Ms. XV-3-76. A few more *Relaciones* are preserved separately elsewhere.

There is a copy of the questionnaire of 22 Jan. 1777 (which most of them answer) in the Archivo General de Indias, Seville, *Indiferente General*, leg. 1544 [145-7-23].
